



# Team Checklist 2022 WCP CUP March 31-April 10

- Roster of players completed in accordance with the 2022 WCP CUP Rules and Regulations on or before 9:00 pm March 25 , 2022. Roster forms to be filled in online at: [www.wcpsport.ca](http://www.wcpsport.ca)
- Waiver forms are now included in the Official Rules and Regulation under Rule #14
- ALL players and staff will be required to have a WCP Cup registered player picture ID card to allow free player entry into the 2022 WCP CUP. We are asking for the team contact to **email head shots of all new players and staff** to [wcpsooccer1@gmail.com](mailto:wcpsooccer1@gmail.com) by **March 25, 2022**. Please name each photo file in the format 'FirstnameLastnameCountryDivision'. Example: **JoeSmithCanadaMens.jpg**.
- All players from out of district must show proof of registration and a letter of good standing from their district/club otherwise they will be required to register as an FCRegina/RSA guest player. Proof of registration must be submitted via email by **March 25** or paper copy sent with team rep to uniform declaration meeting.
- All out of province players need to provide proof of registration and a letter of good standing (Travel Permit) from their provincial association. Proof of registration must be submitted via email by **March 25**.
- Players not registered in the current Indoor Season are required to register as a guest player for the tournament: Youth players up to age 18: please contact the FCRegina office to purchase a youth tournament pass (306-352-8040) Adult players:<http://FCRegina.rampregistrations.com>
- Team personnel includes all non-players that will be on the player bench (i.e., Coach, **Manager, Trainer, Youth Gender Rep**. Team personnel needs to be registered as team personnel within a district to have insurance coverage. Proof of registration is only required for team personnel in a district outside of RSA. Team personnel not registered within a district can register here: <http://FCRegina.rampregistrations.com>
- SAME GENDER ADULT** All youth teams must have at least one adult of the same gender as the players. If none of the registered team officials fit this requirement, a parent may fulfill this role. If not a registered team official, this person does not require an ID card but must be present on the team bench and identified on the game sheet. This person cannot be a registered player on the team. Teams not having an adult of the same gender will result in the match being defaulted to their opponents.
- SSA requires all Coaching Staff to have their **NCCP Coaching Certification** to be eligible to coach from the bench for the tournament. You will be required to enter the NCCP # on the online roster form.
- All team personnel are required to have their **Respect in Sport (RIS) training**. You will be required to enter the RIS # on the online roster form. Take the online program here: <http://www.sasksport.sk.ca/RIS/>
- All members listed on the coaching staff must have completed the NCCP eLearning module [Making Headway – Soccer](#). There is no cost to complete this module.
- 1 rep to attend uniform declaration **March 29, 2022**, at a location and time TBD.
- All teams to have two sets of differently coloured socks, and two sets of numbered home and away jerseys, unless otherwise approved by the WCP Cup OC.
- 10 players in attendance at the official WCP CUP Opening Ceremonies on **March 31, 2022, at 6:00pm**.
- Each team to bring their own country flag to be displayed during opening ceremony parade.
- Each team to provide their own country flag to be hung from team bench during team competition.
- Each team may provide a CD or Mp3 version of team's goal celebration song during FINALS only (optional)
- National Anthem to be provided by WCP Entertainment. (**New teams** provide CD/MP3 version)
