



WCP CUP TEAM CHECKLIST



1

ROSTER-TEAM STATUS FORM:

Submit Roster and Team Status form no later than 7 days prior to the start date of the tournament.

All players and staff must be listed in accordance with the WCP CUP Rules and Regulations. **Player ID Cards** will be issued for all registered team staff and players listed on the roster. ID cards will be available for pick-up on opening day at the facility front desk by your team's designated team representative. Teams will need to provide their own lanyards.

OUT OF PROVINCE PLAYERS will need to provide an INDIVIDUAL or TEAM TRAVEL PERMIT from their local district or Provincial Association. Submit with roster.

TEAM PERSONNEL: will need to be registered within a district to have appropriate insurance coverage. Proof of registration is required for non-local FCRegina Team Personnel. Team Personnel not registered within a district can register here: <http://FCRegina.rampregistrations.com>.

Team Personnel are required to have their Respect In Sport training (RIS) and list their RIS# on the roster form. Online RIS program can be found here <http://www.sasksporet.sk.ca/RIS> (RIS# valid 5yrs)

Saskatchewan Soccer Assoc requires all Coaches listed on team rosters to have their appropriate NCCP Coaching Certification and Making Headway module to be eligible to coach from the bench during all sanctioned tournaments. NCCP# should be listed on the roster form.

RULE OF TWO: Each youth team must have at least two adults present at all times, with at least one adult being the same gender as the players. This requirement applies on the bench, in the dressing room, and in any situation where the athletes might be potentially vulnerable. Gender representatives should have a valid CRC and RIS#.

UNIFORM DECLARATION: Attendance in person or video call may be required by Team Reps to discuss options for team jersey colours. The Home team is required to change due to any conflicts with colours. All teams should have two sets of differently coloured socks, and two sets of numbered Home and Away jerseys, unless otherwise approved by the WCP Organizing Committee

SCOREKEEPER: Each team that is designated as the HOME will be required to provide a scorekeeper for that game. Scorekeeper should be listed on the roster form and game sheet. Scorekeepers will also be on a list to check-in at the front desk. All designated Scorekeepers should meet at center field 5mins before game time to receive instructions to utilize the remotes for the scoreboard. Remotes should be returned to center field 5mins before the end of the game to transfer for the next designated scorekeepers.
